Dear Students and Parents,

No weapons in our schools:

In collaboration with the Superintendent and the Board of Education, the entire staff of the Fond du Lac School District works hard to ensure that all of our schools are safe.

District-Wide Definition:

Weapon means “any knives (including pocket knives), guns, or other objects readily capable of causing bodily harm.”

District Policy 10.636 states:

“Dangerous Weapons in the Schools: Under no circumstances will students be allowed to possess articles which those in authority determine may endanger the health and safety of other students on school property or at school-sponsored events. Such items will be removed from student possession and disciplinary action will result.”

Adopted 10/26/87

Real or look-alike toy weapons have the same consequences if brought to school including, but not limited to: possible expulsions and referrals to the police.

In an effort to continue a safe school climate, we ask that you speak with your student about the seriousness of weapons and the consequences of bringing a weapon to school to help us ensure the safety of the school. The guidance and direction you provide as parents and/ or guardians is absolutely critical as we work together to keep our schools safe.
